M RATED MOVIES - YEARS 7 to 10 only

Throughout the year students in years 7 – 10 may be required to watch M rated movies as part of their studies in subjects including literacy, health or SOSE. The movies chosen are at the discretion of the teacher and do not contain inappropriate language, explicit sex scenes or violence. They are, however, suggested adult themes. If you have any questions please contact your child's teacher. Students without consent will be given alternative work at another location.

LOCAL EXCURSION

Outings within walking distance of the school without cost form an ongoing part of the curriculum. To avoid unnecessary paperwork for both yourself and staff, this approval allows your child to attend all local excursions during the year. An example would be Ferny Creek Reserve.

HEAD LICE

Authorised staff by the school principal may visually check your child's hair for the presence of head lice, when it is suspected that head lice may be present. Prior to any inspection, the student will be advised of the reason why they are being checked and the procedure to be carried out. If head lice/eggs are found, parent/guardians will be notified. Please note, due to the sensitive nature all checks are carried out in private.

DIETARY REQUIREMENTS

PHOTOGRAPHY & FILMING OPT IN/OUT

During the school year there are many occasions and events where staff may photograph, film or record students participating in school activities and events. We do this for many reasons including to celebrate student participation and achievement, showcase learning programs, document a student's learning journey/camps/excursions/sports events etc, communicate with our parents and school community in newsletters and on classroom blogs/apps/insert as appropriate for your school, etc].

This notice applies to photographs, video or recordings of students that are collected, used, and disclosed by the school. We ask that any parents/carers or other members of our school community photographing, filming, or recording students at school events do so in a respectful and safe manner and that any photos, video, or recordings ("images") of students are not publicly posted (e.g., to a social media account) without the permission of the relevant parent/carer.

Under this category there are two separate permissions being requested -

A. Use or disclosure within the school community.

Unless you tell us otherwise below, images of your child may be used by our school within the school community, as described below.

Photographs, video, or recordings of students may be used within the school community in any of the following ways:

- in the school's communication, learning and teaching tools (for example, emails, classroom blogs or apps that can only be accessed by students, parents/carers or school staff with passwords eg Compass, Class Dojo etc)
- for display in school classrooms, on noticeboards etc
- in the school's newsletter
- to support student's health and wellbeing (e.g., photographs of pencil grip to assist in OT assessments)

B. Use or disclosure in publications/locations that are publicly accessible.

Unless you tell us otherwise below, photographs, video or recordings of students may also be used in publications that are accessible to the public, including:

- on the school's website including in the school newsletter which is publicly available on the website
- on the school's social media accounts
- in the school magazine

Your child may be identified by first name only in these images (or not named at all).

We will notify you individually if we are considering using any images of your child for specific advertising or promotional purposes.
